**Course Description and Objectives:** This is a science course elective for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students. The course will introduce the student to basics of human anatomy and the functions of these structures. Also, there will be an emphasis on how the different structures of the body work together and disorders of the human body.
