

COVID-19 7TH-12TH GRADES PLANS AND PROCEDURES

All classrooms have desks that are socially distanced by 6 feet. Masks/face coverings must be worn by students and teachers when entering the building, when changing classes, and any other time they are in the hallways or if they cannot social distance. Students are allowed to wear masks/face coverings, if preferred, in class even when social distancing is achieved.

Classes that are larger than the maximum classroom capacity will meet in the larger areas of the school – Mary's Kitchen, Media Center, music room, Porter Building, and science lab.

Middle school students will enter the building directly into A hall and go to Block A.

All students will wash their hands in the A hall restroom as they enter the building.

High school students will enter through the gym doors and wash their hands in the gym foyer restrooms before going directly to their Block A class. Students who will have Block A in the Porter building (where they will wash their hands) or the Media Center will enter those areas directly. Students who begin in the Media Center will wash hands in the B hall restroom.

Lockers will not be used at this time. Students will bring their backpacks to each classroom. Any student who has physical needs and cannot carry their backpack to class will be provided a locker.

B and C hallways will be one way so that, at class change, all students are walking in the same direction. Masks/face coverings must be worn during class change.

A hall restroom will be used by middle school students only.

B hall restroom will be used by 9th and 10th grade students only.

C hall restroom will be used by 11th and 12th grade students only.

Only one person at a time will be allowed in the restrooms. These areas will be monitored by teacher's aides sitting outside the restrooms.

Break and lunch will be brought to the classrooms. (See the cafeteria plan for specifics.) There will be no vending machines at this time.

Each student will bring their own canister of disinfecting wipes and will wipe down their desk before and after use. There will be no sharing of supplies. Each student will be given a list of needed materials to bring for class.
